

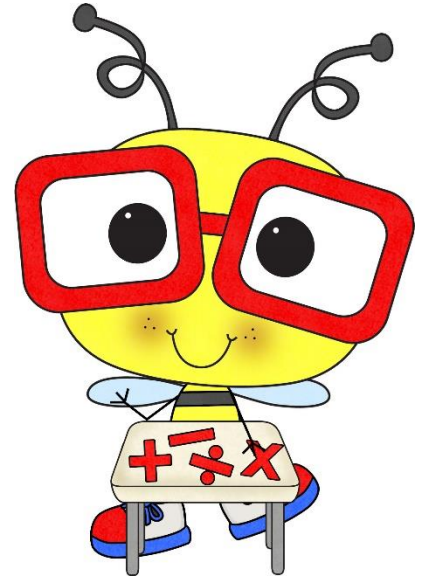
# Summer Term in P3



The topics we cover in the Summer Term provide great opportunities to develop independent research skills and explore the outdoors.

## Maths

- **Number** - strategies to add and subtract TENS and UNITS. Looking at sets of 2, 5 and 10.
- **Time** - o'clock, quarter past, half past and quarter to (analogue) o'clock and half past (digital).
- **Money** - drawing coins and showing amounts to £1. Finding change to 80p.
- **Shape and Space** - 2D and 3D shapes. Basic symmetry.
- **Fractions** -  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\frac{3}{4}$
- **Numbots** - please encourage your child to use the programme regularly to develop quick recall of number facts.



## Literacy

- **Punctuation** - Capital Letters, Full Stops, Exclamation Marks and Question Marks
- **Nouns, Adjectives and Verbs** - encourage use of adjectives in independent writing.
- **Alphabetical Order**
- **Speech Bubbles**
- A/an
- **Opposites** and words that have similar meanings.
- **Comprehension Skills**
- **Poetry**

## Explore and Investigate

### Dinosaurs

- Independent research on dinosaurs.
- Understand the concept of extinction.
- Paint/draw dinosaurs.
- Build a dinosaur using 'recyclable materials'.
- Explore dinosaur fiction and fact.
- Create dinosaur fact files.



### Minibeasts

- Independent research on minibeasts.
- Life cycles (frog, butterfly, bee).
- Observe minibeasts in their natural habitats.
- Drawing/painting symmetrical insects.
- Labelling insects.
- Explore minibeast stories.

If your child is particularly enthusiastic about any of the above areas please encourage this and allow them to explore it independently.
